“The Show Must Goes Online!” Summer Arts Programs at Depot Lane for its 19th Season.. Virtually.

Registration is now open for the **19th annual Summer Youth Cultural & Performing Arts Program at Depot Lane Theater** in Schoharie. The 2020 programs are offering two camps; Vocal Camp entitled ***The Show Must Go Online!*** and Instrumental Band Camp ***Build-Your-Own Band Camp***.

The first program, entitled ***The Show Must Go Online!***, is July 13 – 17, directed by SaraJane Cipperly. ***The Show*** is a first-of-its kind musical work where each actor will prepare a 1-2 minute scene/song to rehearse, video record, and upload. All the scenes will be put together into one video to tell the hilarious story of a group of passionate students desperate to keep their annual musical alive... online! Children will have the opportunity to learn about vocal production and technique, song choice; auditioning tips, as well as drama/stage exercises. Group and individual vocal instruction will be available. All instruction will be offered virtually. Children entering grades 3 – 9 may register for this camp.

For students entering 7th through 12th grades, the **Build-Your-Own Band Camp** workshops begin on Monday, August 10th and run through Friday, August, 14th under the instruction of Mrs. Jessica Gould, and Dr. Timothy Solinger. The camp will give students the unique opportunity to choose lessons and activities specific to their interests as well as offering group instruction. Students can work on Jazz Improv, perform Pop or Show Tunes, learn a 2nd instrument, small ensemble work, and Composition. There will be opportunities for collaborative and individual work as students prepare contributions for a “Virtual Recital”. Students in grades entering 7 to 12 (or by permission of instructor) are invited to participate. Space is limited for this camp and students must be proficient on their primary musical instrument. Registered students for Band Camp are asked to submit a short video of themselves playing so the instructors can see where

there are at in their skills. This is not an audition, but rather to help the instructors better prepare for each student's individual goals.

This project is made possible with funds from the Decentralization Program, a regrant program of the New York State Council on the Arts with the support of Governor Andrew M. Cuomo and the New York State Legislature and administered in Schoharie County by Greene County Council on the Arts dba CREATE. Students must register to take part in the program.
